



<b>S</b>	<b>Substitute</b>	To have a person or thing act or serve in the place of another. Who else? What else? Other place? Time?
<b>C</b>	<b>Combine</b>	To bring together, to unite. Combine what? Bring whom together? Combine purposes? Ideas? Materials?
<b>A</b>	<b>Adjust</b>	To adapt for the purpose of suiting a condition. Reshape? Tune-up? Tone-down? Accommodate? Agree?
<b>M</b>	<b>Modify</b>	To alter, to change the form or quality. Other color? Sound? Motion? Form? Size? Shape? Taste? Odor?
	<b>Magnify</b>	To enlarge, to make greater in form or quality. Add what to make higher? Stronger? Thicker? Longer?
	<b>Minify</b>	To make less, to minimize. Make what smaller? Lighter? Slower? Less frequent? Shrink? Reduce?
<b>P</b>	<b>Put to Other Uses</b>	Use for purpose other than originally intended. Use when? How?
<b>E</b>	<b>Eliminate</b>	To remove, omit, or get ride of a quality. What to cut out? Remove? Simplify? Weed out?
<b>R</b>	<b>Reverse</b>	To make opposite or contrary. To turn what around? Upside down? Inside out? 180° flip?
	<b>Rearrange</b>	Change order or sequence. Other pattern? Layout? Plan? Scheme? Regroup? Redistribute?
