AP CELL PHONE POLICY:

Cell phones and other electronic or communication devices are **not** allowed in an AP testing room or site. If a student uses a cell phone, digital camera, MP3 player, PDA, BlackBerry, Bluetooth-enabled device, email/messaging device, or any other electronic or communication device **IN THE TESTING ROOM or DURING A BREAK**, the device will be confiscated and the student will be dismissed from AP testing.

BROWARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD POLICY:

Students in AP classes will be required to take the Advanced Placement examination in order to receive two quality points. If a student elects **not** to take the examination, he/she will receive one quality point for a grade of "C" or higher.

TRANSPORTATION ARRANGEMENTS:

Students must make afternoon transportation arrangements prior to the day of testing. Students **may not** leave the test early or call parents if the test is running late. Afternoon tests usually conclude between 3:45 and 4:15 p.m.

COMPLETING EXAM RESPONSES:

Scores on the multiple-choice sections of the AP Exams are based on the number of questions answered **CORRECTLY**. You won't receive or lose points for incorrect answers or unanswered questions. See Page 6 of your AP Bulletin "Completing Exam Responses" for more information.
