Student Parking Plan 2011 - 2012



Who qualifies for parking?

At the time of application:

1. The student must be a **senior** (minimum of 17 academic credits earned by August 2011)
2. The student must have an **un-weighted GPA** of 2.0 or higher
3. The student cannot have more than 3 behavioral referrals from the 2010-2011 school year
4. The student cannot have more than 20 absences (excused or unexcused) in the previous semester (Spring 2011)
5. The student must not have any outstanding student obligations (Check Virtual Counselor)

How may the 12th Grade student apply for parking?

1. Download and complete all the registration forms; It is required that student and parent/guardian sign and date both forms
 - a. 2011-2012 Student Parking Registration Form
 - b. 2011-2012 Student Parking and Driving Policies
2. Students applying for a parking permit must provide a **photocopy** of the following:
 - a. Valid Florida Driver's License
 - b. Proof of Insurance (Valid for the dates student is parked on school grounds)
 - c. Valid Vehicle Registration
3. Only the student or parent/guardian of the student may apply for the parking decal (Verified through our school records)
4. All applications will be taken on a First Come, First Served Basis
5. The Cost is \$75.00 plus a \$1.50 non-refundable online processing fee; total cost of 76.50 for the school year. ONLINE PURCHASE ONLY
6. **Students who do not meet the above requirements will not be issued a senior parking decal. A Refund of the \$75.00 will be issued where applicable.**

Online sales will be available at Douglasshigh.com from August 1, 2011 to August 11, 2011 or until decals sell out.

Note: *If the allotted slots have been sold, students meeting eligibility requirements will be placed on a waiting list.*

2011 - 2012 Student Parking and Driving Policies



1. Your parking DECAL will be issued and placed in your vehicle by an MSD Staff Member only.
2. A valid operator's license must be held by all students driving and parking on school grounds.
3. The speed limit on school grounds is 15 mph. All vehicles will follow the proper directions, signs and indicated arrows on the roadway or lose parking privileges.
4. School Board Policy #5307: "The Board shall not be responsible for damage to automobiles or other vehicles which are parked or operated on school property." REPORT ANY DAMAGE IMMEDIATELY TO SECURITY.
5. At no time may a student park in the faculty parking lot. (Disciplinary action as per the Code of Student Conduct)
6. Students are not to sit in cars parked in the parking lot during the school day. Loitering in the lot will not be permitted.

THIS INCLUDES LUNCH PERIODS.

***YOUR CAR IS NOT A LOCKER.** If you need to go to your vehicle for any reason during the school day, you must obtain permission from your **Administrator Only.**

7. Parking on the grass or "double parking" is not allowed (it is considered illegal parking).
8. Valuables should not be left in vehicles. All vehicles should be locked and secured.
9. All vehicles are subject to search for illegal objects and substances if reasonable suspicion that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, weapons, or other contraband might be present in that vehicle. **Decal holders are responsible for all items found in their vehicle.**
10. Parking permits are NOT TRANSFERABLE to another vehicle or another student. If a decal is found on another vehicle, both parties lose decals and face disciplinary action.
11. Students must use due care and respect for others in the operation of their vehicles.
12. Loud stereos, radios and faulty alarms will not be tolerated and will result in parking permit being revoked.
13. Since the parking and operation of student vehicles on campus is a privilege, violations of any of the student parking policies will result in the following:

1st Violation: Security Written Citation & Parent Notification

2nd Violation: Security Written Citation, Parent Notification & 2 Week Decal Suspension
(at the end of the 2 weeks a new Decal must be purchased for \$10)

3rd Violation: Permanent Decal Suspension (loss of parking privilege on school grounds)

14. Students who do not maintain an un-weighted GPA of 2.0, cut class, and/or have discipline problems are subject to revocation of parking permit.
15. All vehicles must park with their front facing the wheel stops (or be ticketed for illegal parking). ***NO BACKING IN!**
16. Replacement permits should be taken care of **before** driving the vehicle to school.
17. When signing in late, you must park in the visitor lot, sign in the Student Services Office then move your vehicle to the Student Lot. Students that leave their vehicles in the Visitor lot will receive disciplinary action.
18. Eligible seniors may purchase only one decal. If a replacement decal is needed, you must bring the old decal to the Director of Student Parking with a \$10.00 sticker fee. If the decal was destroyed in an accident a Police report MUST be presented to purchase a new decal.
19. The decal must be affixed to the bottom of the windshield on the driver's side.
20. Students who operate vehicles in an unsafe or reckless manner on school property, on streets adjacent to the school, around school buses, or while driving to and from school, will face disciplinary action.

Parking rules & all road regulations are strictly enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on campus. The administrative staff shall have the right to remove the parking permit of any student in violation of the above rules and regulations or for any serious school rule infraction. I understand that these rules apply before, during and after school. Any violations are subject to disciplinary action.
