

# UPGRADE TO MAC MIDRANGE CLIENT V2.0d2

## STEP 1: LOG ON TO SBBC

- Select **Apple Menu/Chooser**.
- Click once on **Appleshare** to select/highlight.
- In AppleTalk Zone locate and select **TSSC**.
- In File Server list locate and select **ETS01**.
- Connect to ETS01 Server as Guest. Click **OK**.
- Select **SBBC**. Click **OK**. An SBBC icon is now on your desktop. (This icon is a shortcut to the application software that is stored on the district network.)
- Close the Appleshare window.
- Double click on the **SBBC** icon. After it opens single click the **Macintosh** folder and then **open BRIO INSTALLS**.

## STEP 2: INSTALL MAC MIDRANGE

- Double-click **MacMidrange Client 2.0d2**.
- Double-click **Client Installer**. Click **Accept** license.
- A window appears. Choose Uninstall from the dropdown box located in the upper left corner of the window. Click Uninstall and follow instructions on screen.
- When Uninstall is complete, choose Custom Install from the dropdown box located in the upper left corner of the window.
- Click on **SQL DATABASE ACCESS** and **ODBC DRIVERS** to select these items for your custom install.
- At the bottom of the window where it says 'Install Location: ' make sure the destination is your hard drive.
- Click **Install** and follow instructions on screen. Click Restart when install is done.

## STEP 3: CONFIGURE the Data Warehouse AS400 entry (in MacMidrange).

- After Restart go to the Menu bar and click **Apple Menu/Control Panels/MacMidrange Config**. A MacMidrange panel will appear on your screen.
- Click on **Add**. Complete the panel with the Data Warehouse AS/400 information shown below:
  - AS/400 Connect: **AS9625C**
  - ID: Your BRIO User Id
  - Connection: TCP/IP info
  - IP Address: **10.252.0.135**
- Click **OK** and close the dialog box.

If your Interaccess was configured for TERMS, installing BRIO wiped it out and you must add your AS400 setting back into MacMidrange.

- To reconfigure your local AS400 entry (for access to TERMS).
  - AS/400 Connect: **AS400**
  - ID: Your BRIO User Id or any id.
  - Connection: TCP/IP info
  - IP Address: **Your school's IP Address.**  
To find your school's IP Address check with your DPC or TLC.

## STEP 4: SETUP ODBC PPC

- Go to Menu bar and click **Apple Menu/Control Panels/ODBC Setup PPC**.
- A window will appear. **Click on Setup Data Sources**.
- Select **ADD** button.
- Select **MacMidrange ODBC PPC** setup data source and click **OK**.
- A window with five tab buttons will appear. You will enter information into each tab. To access a tab click on the tab name. The graphic below displays (left to right) the tab names, the field names that need to be modified, and the values for those fields.

**DO NOT click OK until you have completed all five tabs.**
