Description of ESOL Program

The Broward County Public Schools offer English Language Learners (ELLs) instructional services through the following types of instructional delivery models:

- **Sheltered Instruction/Self-contained Classes**
- **Basic Mainstream Instruction K-12**

In both of these instructional delivery models, the instruction provided to ELLs is equal to the instruction provided to the non-ELLs at the same grade levels. ESOL strategies are used to help students understand instruction provided. In addition, the courses, books and other instructional materials used by ELLs are comparable to those used by their non-ELL counterparts.

These two types of instructional delivery models are implemented through the following placement options:
