

ESOL TRAINING REQUIREMENT COURSE OVERVIEW

<u>CAT I - ESOL ENDORSEMENT COURSES</u> - (Delivery Method – Structured Coaching/Mentoring)

Applied Linguistics, Cross-Cultural Communications, ESOL Curriculum & Materials Development, ESOL Testing & Evaluation, and Methods of Teaching ESOL

<u>Target Audience</u>: Primary Language Arts/English, Developmental Language Arts, Intensive Reading, Reading (60 Inservice Points)

The CAT I courses require the use of <u>one</u> book titled "The Cross-Cultural Language and Academic Development Handbook" 3rd Edition. For information on how to order your book, click on the following link: www.broward.k12.fl.us/esol/Eng/ESOL/ESOLEndorsement.htm

After completing all five CAT I ESOL Endorsement courses and inservice points have been **posted** to your inservice record, teachers **must apply** for their ESOL endorsement. Download the District Version CG-10 form from the Certification Department's web site www.broward.k12.fl.us/certification/Forms.html. Completed application forms **must** be sent to the Certification Department at the K.C. Wright Bldg. for processing.

CAT II ESOL STRATEGIES FOR CONTENT AREA TEACHERS

Target Audience: Mathematics, Social Studies, Science & Computer Literacy Teachers (60 Inservice Points)

CAT III ISSUES & STRATEGIES FOR TEACHING LEP STUDENTS

<u>Target Audience</u>: Related subjects other than English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Computer Literacy (including Occupational and Physical Therapists). (18 Inservice Points)

CAT III FOR STUDENT SERVICE PROVIDERS

<u>Target Audience</u>: School Psychologists, Speech/Language Pathologists, & Social Workers **Only.** (18 Inservice Points) This course will be offered once a year during the winter/spring semester.

Once you complete the training requirements for the CAT II or CAT III course, you will be required to complete a BCPS **Verification of ESOL Training** form. This form will be issued to BCPS participants <u>only</u> at the final session. The ESOL Training Department will submit the forms to the Certification Department once your inservice points are posted to your inservice record. Once confirmed by Certification, your records in SAP will be updated to reflect this qualification.

CAT IV ESOL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS & CAT IV GUIDANCE COUNSELORS

Target Audience: School Administrators and Guidance Counselors - (60 Inservice Points)
