WHAT'S NEW FOR 2009-2010?

- 🍏 Beginning on July 1, 2009, the option or choice of receiving ESOL services at an ESOL Cluster School will no longer be available.
- 🍏 The home school must provide ESOL services to all students who register and qualify for the ESOL Program.
- 🍏 The Cluster School option has been removed from the ESOL form titled *Parent Notification of Student Placement in the English for Speakers of Other Languages Program*.
- 🍏 The decision to eliminate ESOL Cluster Schools was approved and supported by the Principal Executive Groups as well as Instructional Council.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- 🍏 Notify all pertinent staff members of this important change in ESOL student placement.
- 🍏 Ensure that school staff is using the updated form titled *Parent Notification of Student Placement in the English for Speakers of Other Languages Program* when notifying parents of entry into the ESOL program.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- 🍏 Students will not be serviced by the home school, which will impact funding.
