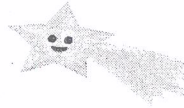


Student Tutoring and Resource Program

After-school STAR: Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday, 3:00pm-4:45pm

The Student Tutoring And Resource Program (STAR) will provide students an opportunity to excel in their courses. Teachers and peer tutors will provide assistance to student. All students are eligible, as long as, they follow these simple guidelines:

- Students must bring any issued Instructional Focus Calendars (IFC).
- Student must be prepared to work and follow school rules.
- Student must have a valid parent contact phone number.
- Computers are to be used for research and classroom assignments only.
- Students are not allowed to wander throughout the media center. An area of the media center will be designated for each subject.
- Students must report to the media center by 3:00 for afternoon STAR.
- Students without the proper materials will not be allowed to enter the media center.
- Students are not permitted to wander the campus.
- Students must remain in the media center until 4:45.
- Upon leaving the media center at 4:45, students will receive a pass from a STAR instructor to ride the activity bus.
- Cell phone use is not permitted in the media center, unless approved by teacher.

Consequences for misbehavior in STAR:

1. Removal from the media center. Parent contact. One week suspension from STAR
2. Removal from the media center. Parent contact. Three week suspension from STAR
3. Removal from the media center. Parent contact. Nine week suspension from STAR
