SUBJECT: **NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND/SCHOOL PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY  
REPORT (NCLB/SPAR)**



The No Child Left Behind (NCLB) federal legislation and Florida statute require that schools provide parents an annual school status report at the beginning of each school year. The Florida Department of Education has produced a No Child Left Behind/School Public Accountability Report (NCLB/SPAR) for each school containing all the required NCLB indicators, including the indicator on Annual Year Progress (AYP). The DOE has recently posted the NCLB SPARs online. A link to the report is available on our District's School Improvement website at: <http://www.broward.k12.fl.us/schoolimprove/DOEreports.htm>.

The NCLB/SPAR for the 2010-11 school year contains all the indicators required. Schools are not required to add any additional information. Each school must make the 2010-11 NCLB/SPAR available to every parent immediately. Schools are not required to distribute the report to parents, but notice of availability of the NCLB/SPAR should be distributed widely (newsletters, bulletin boards, public announcements at meetings, etc.). You should keep a printed copy of the SPAR at the school.
