- 2. Click on Gifted Symposium on the left hand side.**
- 3. Select Gifted & Advanced Learner Symposium on the left hand side.**
- 4. Parents of Broward County Students who have used the e-store before, proceed as usual. If not, follow instructions below.**

To registrants who have never used the e-store you MUST create a user account. Registrants without students must enter a "dummy" student profile prior to checking out. Instructions are below:

- 5. Click the blue highlighted link [Gifted & Advanced Learner Symposium](#).**
- 6. Enter the quantity of tickets you wish to purchase and click "Add to Cart."**
- 7. Click "Checkout."**
- 8. On this screen, if you have never used the E-store before, you must create a new user. (If you have used the E-store before, use the login you have used in the past.)**
- 9. For non-parent users, click "create new" and add a dummy student profile on the next screen.**

Click "Add Student Profile" on the upper left next to the red writing, enter John Doe and the student ID of "1"

Click "Save Changes."

For parents of Broward County students, enter your student's information instead of the dummy profile.

10. For each ticket you buy, select the student profile you entered from the drop down menu, and click "Next." This is where most customers get stuck. A snapshot of the drop-down menu is below.

11. Enter billing information and click "Next."

12. Enter your credit card information and click "Review Order."

13. Review your order and click "Place order."

Note to Broward Educators: Kindly submit a supervisor-approved TDA with to your Area Office. Be sure to note on the TDA that the cost is \$25.00 and that it will be paid for by your school. Register on the e-store using your personal credit card. If an approved TDA is on file at your Area Office, the school will be given permission to reimburse you..
