5. The selected employee must have received a highly effective or effective on their overall evaluation and final Instructional Practice Score (IPS). Talent Acquisition & Operations will review scores end of May.
6. Provide 9 hours instruction to students, participating in all meal activities (breakfast, lunch and snack time), meeting and greeting families as they drop off and pick up their VPK student, and assisting students with their toileting needs if such assistance is required.
