1. The employee holds a valid Florida Educator certificate in Pre-K/Primary (Age 3 - Grade 3).
2. Employee has taught one (1) school year in Pre-K within the past three (3) years.
3. Instructional employees are required to complete and submit the 2017 Summer Term Application to be considered for a Summer Term position.
4. Employee must attend mandatory training and planning. Failure to attend will result in ineligibility for summer term position. VPK staff development/class set up will be held on June 12, 2017.
5. The selected employee must be reappointed for the 2017-2018 school year.
6. The selected employee must have received a highly effective or effective on their overall evaluation and final Instructional Practice Score (IPS). Talent Acquisition and Operations will review scores end of May.
7. Provide 9 hours of daily instruction to students, participating in all meal activities (breakfast, lunch and snack time), meeting and greeting families as they drop off and pick up their VPK student, and assisting students with their toileting needs if such assistance is required.
8. Participate in one paid day for classroom closing & delivery of materials to KCW, 6th floor on August 10, 2017.
9. Successfully complete the online Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards for Four-Year-Olds professional development course prior to teaching. 5. The selected employee must be reappointed for the 2017-2018 school year.
6. The selected employee must have received a highly effective or effective on their final Instructional Practice Score (IPS). Instructional Staffing will review scores end of May.
