- 2. Employee has taught one (1) school year in Pre-K within the past three (3) years.
- 3. Instructional employees are required to complete and submit the 2016 Summer Term Application to be considered for a Summer Term position.
- 4. The selected employee must be reappointed for the 2016-2017 school year.
- 5. The selected employee must have received a highly effective or effective on their overall evaluation and final Instructional Practice Score (IPS). Talent Acquisition and Operations will review scores end of May.
- 6. Provide 9 hours instruction to students, participating in all meal activities (breakfast, lunch and snack time), meeting and greeting families as they drop off and pick up their VPK student, and assisting students with their toileting needs if such assistance is required.
- 7. Participate in one paid day for VPK staff development/class set up. Required staff development will be held on June 13, 2016.
