

Enhancing a Podcasts with Keynote


Open Keynote, choose a theme, and save the file.

Using the inspector, click the Document icon.

Pull down the Slide Size to Custom slide size

Change the width and height to 300 pixels.


This makes for a very small size to layout your slide. However, it is the proper size for a Podcast.



Create slides you need for your podcast and save them.

The Keynote presentation is ready to be inserted into a Podcast.


View the presentation in Light Table view (View / Light Table) so all the slides are visible.



Open Garage Band.

Drag a slide from Keynote to the beginning of the Podcast track.

Please note: This is the same track to which you add other media.




Play the audio and stop when you think the next image should be added.

Drag that image into the Podcast track.

Continue in this manner until all images have been added.

Play the Podcast to make sure the timing is correct and the music doesn't overpower the narration. Adjust accordingly.



Photos, songs, and movies created by others are usually protected by copyright.

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- **Images and Photos: 5 works by one author; up to 10% or 15 works, whichever is less, from a collection.**
- **Songs: 10% or 30 seconds, whichever is less.**
- **Motion Media: 10% or 3 minutes, whichever is less.**

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
