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Quality Awards Recognize Superior Programs within Broward County Schools



First Place Intermediate went to Cypress Bay High School / South Central Area Office / ETS for their project - "On-line Student Scheduling" and 1st Place in the Novice category went to Advanced Academic Programs / Core Curriculum / Guidance for their project on "Increasing and Enrollment Access Advanced Academics."

Storyboard winners in the Collaborative Applicants Category went to First Place -North Central Area Assistant Principal **Council** for their "ASPIRE" project, 2nd Place North Central Area Superintendent's "Working Collaboratively Office for Achievement Increase Student and Attendance by Reducing External Suspensions, and 3rd Place went to the **Digital Education Teacher Academy** project Standards-based Professional Development Partnership."

Within the District Applicants Category for their Written Application, Instructional Staffing won 1st Place Exemplary for "I. S. Express," Supply Management and Logistics won 1st Place Intermediate Level for their project - "Purchasing Card Program" and Risk Management took 1st Place Novice for their project - "Workers' Comp Works for You!"




CAB TIP – Creating a Bookmark Folder to house your Bookmarks


What is a bookmark? A link, stored in a special Bookmarks folder, that points to another object.

Create a new folder on your CAB desktop by selecting **File>New>New Folder**.

Name your folder by selecting the "new folder" icon, then selecting File>Get Info (Mac) or File>Properties (Win).

Open your newly created folder and begin creating your bookmarks by selecting File>New>New Bookmark.





From the Bookmark "Info" window, name your new bookmark and give it a "subject".



You can change the icon of your bookmark by clicking and holding the mouse in the square below.




Next, Select the "Advanced" tab.



From the "Advanced" tab, enter the url in the window below or drag a url link directly into this field.

Select OK to save your bookmark.

You can edit your bookmark at anytime by double-clicking it, which will open the Bookmark info window.





To use a Bookmark, just open your Bookmarks folder and select a bookmark from your list.

You can now double-click on your bookmark to open the specific website.





For more CAB TIPS, open BCPS Resources, then open CAB Q & A, then CAB TIPS. You can add any conference to your CAB desktop by highlighting the conference and selecting Collaborate>Add to Desktop. This places an alias(shortcut) of that conference directly on **your** CAB Desktop.
