Major Concepts/Content Seminar of Success

The Seminar of Success (S.O.S.) is an orientation course that gives students the necessary tools for success in academic achievement and the ability to relate what is learned with real-life experience and a variety of postsecondary options. S.O.S. is a needs-based modular curriculum. Character Traits are integrated throughout the program and lessons lead to higher-level critical thinking as found in the FCAT. Upon completion of this course each student will select a Career Pathway that will be implemented into the Career Education Plan and facilitate course selection for the remainder of high school, as well as preparation for postsecondary matriculation. Students will have the opportunity to experience success and develop positive attitudes towards self, school, community, and lifelong learning. The curriculum accents study strategies, social skills, test preparation, content area reading strategies, service learning, action-based research and technology as a vehicle to self-discovery and career exploration. An emphasis is placed on the Career Planning Portfolio, including a career project and four-year plan. Guest speakers include leaders from business and industry.

This program enables students to work with local community service and business organizations to gain valuable on-the-job experience. Students will be exposed to all aspects of industry in a career of interest. Students will be required to work with the school-based coordinator to connect academic competencies to the workplace. The content will include, but not be limited to, the following: discussion of professional job requirements -building vocabulary appropriate to the area of professional interest-development of decision-making skills -development of personal and educational job-related skills work ethics, critical thinking, decision making, career planning process and analysis of career options. Interns will keep daily journals and develop a semester project. The internship will be aligned to the student's career interest area. Internships are non-paid and students are responsible for providing their own transportation and insurance.
