CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT (POLICY 5.8)

WHAT ELSE IS NEW FOR 2008-2009?

- Workback from expulsion abeyance for "Battery on a teacher/school district employee" is no longer allowed.
- Parents should contact law enforcement directly for serious incidents that do not occur on School Board property. Bullying incidents should still be reported to school administrators.
- ♠ Make up work for an "I" grade must be completed by the end of the next marking period.
- Cell phones are allowed on buses under certain conditions. Texting is always allowed.
- The Media Release Form options delineate between school and District communications.
- Added a comprehensive bullying definition, including cyberbullying.
- Dress code changes: Spaghetti straps/tank tops are allowed as long as they are covered by an overblouse or jacket; articles of clothing with spikes or sharp objects are not allowed.
- ♠ Notified parents of the DOE's electronic device rule during FCAT testing: "within arm's reach" mandatory invalidation.
- Referrals for counseling services are included under "Offenses for Mandatory Expulsion".
- ★ Limits make-up work for credit and grades to excused absences only.
- Two videos were created; one for elementary and one for secondary schools.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- **★** Using the Curriculum Guide, review the Code of Student Conduct with staff and students.
- ♠ Require <u>all</u> students to return a signed "Parent/Student Acknowledgement & Media Release Form" within 3 days of receipt of the Code and enter the Media Release response on TERMS.
- Have students watch the appropriate videos on BECON.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- ★ You may violate Florida statutes by not notifying students, parents, and staff of the rules.
- You will not have the signed Acknowledgment & Media Release Form when you need it.
