PART C TRANSITION

WHAT ELSE IS NEW FOR 2008-2009?

As part of IDEA 2004, the District is required to have an Individual Education Plan developed and implemented on the third birthday for children with disabilities exiting Part C (birth-2 program) who are eligible for Part B (3-21).

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

■ ESE Specialists must work collaboratively with the area preschool assessment teams to schedule the student's staffing as early as possible, but no later than their third birthday.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- ***** The School District will be sited by the State.
- ★ The School District will need to write an action plan on how we are rectifying the situation.
- The School District will be monitored by the state for up to five years.
- The School District will lose funding.

WHO NEEDS TO KNOW?

HOW WILL YOU COMMUNICATE FOLLOW-UP?

- The District will keep principals informed on the monitoring of the preschool ESE students.
- Area ESE Assessment teams will coordinate implementation and procedures with the ESE Specialist.
