

ELEMENTARY SPANISH ENRICHMENT

WHAT ELSE IS NEW FOR 2008-2009?

- Kindergarten Spanish Enrichment – Regular classroom teachers who are bilingual will teach calendar math in Spanish every other day.
- Students will learn the language in content as research indicates this is the best way to acquire a second language during an early age.
- No extra funds needed for the implementation.
- Every year a grade will be added.
- Starting next school year, 3 elementary schools have volunteered to offer Spanish Enrichment in Kindergarten to better serve their community: Gator Run, West Hollywood, and Chapel Trail.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- Ask the bilingual teachers (Spanish/English) at your school if they want to volunteer for the program. A grade will be added each year. Contact the World Languages Curriculum Specialists to provide dual language training for teachers.
