

SB 1908 CTACE CHANGE – PRACTICAL ARTS COURSES

WHAT ELSE IS NEW FOR 2008-2009?

- Certain career and technical education practical arts courses have been reinstated as one of the optional one credit courses required for high school graduation.
- Currently one course in fine and performing arts is required for high school graduation.
- With the new legislative change a student can select either a fine and performing arts course or one of the approved career and technical education practical arts courses.
- Florida DOE will provide a list to the districts identifying the career and technical education practical arts courses that will be approved options.
- Policy 6000.1 will be revised to reflect the changes.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- Principals and Guidance Counselors should be aware of the changes that will be coming.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- The school will be out of compliance with new state law and pending changes to Policy 6000.1
