

HIGH SCHOOL - COLLEGE PLACEMENT TEST (CPT)

WHAT'S NEW FOR 2009-2010?

- The College Placement Test (CPT) will be scheduled for October 2009 and January 20, 2010 – February 26, 2010.
- Courses to remediate students who were unsuccessful on the CPT during the 2008-2009 academic year will be available to students for the 2009-2010 school year.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- Work with your school's Guidance Department and Broward College Testing Administrators to appropriately identify qualifying students and schedule the CPT test at your school.
- Consider implementing the electronic CPT assessment at your school. This program adjusts to the level of the student, based on their responses, and will end the assessment when a final level is determined. The electronic CPT assessment is completed in less time than the paper and pencil version.
- For students that were unsuccessful on the CPT test during the 2008-2009 academic year, the following courses are now available to students for registration at your school:
 1. Math for College Success (1 credit); Course Code Number 1200410
 2. Math for College Readiness (1/2 credit): Course Code Number 1200700
 3. Reading for College Success (1/2 credit): Course Code Number 10083500
 4. Writing for College Success (1/2 credit): Course Code Number 10093700

Students must take a final exam created by Broward College for all courses except Math for College Readiness. Final Examination for Math for College Readiness will be re-taking the CPT. Students must pass the final examination in the respective course to pass the class.
