

## HIGH SCHOOL CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE) PROGRAM AND COURSE CHANGES

### WHAT'S NEW FOR 2009-2010?

Effective with the 2009-2010 school-year, many CTE programs, courses, and numbers have been changed, per the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE).

- 🍏 The term “Academy of” has been removed from the state frameworks to avoid confusion with programs that have been designated as a “Career Academy”.
- 🍏 All PSAV programs at the Technical Centers have been divided into courses. Some of the lengthy programs have been split into multiple shorter programs. Over 400 programs, courses and numbers are affected.
- 🍏 There are three new middle school Family & Consumer Sciences courses that have a career focus.
