WHAT IS NEW FOR 2009-2010?

- The new SpringBoard mathematics book is a candidate for statewide mathematics adoption. The District will continue to implement SpringBoard mathematics with last year's texts and "in-house" training. The implementation will be purely "in-house"; The College Board will not participate in mathematics implementation to avoid conflict with the adoption process.
- "In-house" SpringBoard advanced mathematics training will take place August 3-4 for teachers who have completed beginning training.
- SpringBoard language arts books are new. All SpringBoard language arts teachers who have completed beginning training should be retrained in the use of the new materials August 3-4.
- Beginning SpringBoard training in language arts and mathematics will take place August 3-6. This is the only SpringBoard training available for the 2009-10 school year.
