- BEEP has a new look which organizes lesson plans for easy use by teachers.
- Lesson plans already available include K-12 Mathematics, K-12 Social Studies, K-5 and HS Reading, 6-12 World Languages, 6-12 Science, and 9-12 Language Arts.
- Expected to be available as early as August 2007 are lesson plans inclusive of K-5 Science, K-8 Language Arts, 6-8 Reading, K-5 World Languages, K-8 Art.
- All course lesson plans include updated ESOL strategies, ESE accommodations information, and direct links to instructional videos.
- Computers used to access the BEEP lesson plans must have Quicktime and Adobe Acrobat Reader installed on them in order to access the enriched features of the ESOL Strategies, ESE accommodations, and instructional videos.
