Teachers who have not attended textbook adoption training need to contact their department chairs and attend the training offered by the World Languages department during the planning week in August. □ Teachers need to register online with the textbook publisher in order to provide their students with Internet access to the textbook. A site license is issued for each textbook purchased. If the school did not purchase a textbook for each student, the student will not be able to access the online site. Teachers need to access BEEP to familiarize themselves with the lesson plans, curriculum maps and other resources available. WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?
