WHAT ELSE IS NEW FOR 2007-2008?

- ☐ Teachers will use newly adopted textbooks.
- ☐ Cutting-edge technology included in the new adoption should be visible in classroom instruction. Students will be able to access the new textbooks online.
- ☐ Many teachers have been trained in the use of the new materials and the latest research-based methodology for second language acquisition.
- ☐ The District has developed curriculum maps and lesson plans that are available to teachers via BEEP.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- ☐ Teachers who have not attended textbook adoption training need to contact their department chairs and attend the training offered by the World Languages department during the planning week in August.
- ☐ Teachers need to register online with the textbook publisher in order to provide their students with Internet access to the textbook. A site license is issued for each textbook purchased. If the school did not purchase a textbook for each student, the student will not be able to access the online site.
- ☐ Teachers need to access BEEP to familiarize themselves with the lesson plans, curriculum maps and other resources available.

- ☐ Students' academic achievement may be hindered.
