WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?	
	Ensure your guidance staff has completed a review of the key performance indicators and the District activities and determined the most effective guidance program for your school.
	Provide counselor access to classrooms and computer labs to assist students in setting achievement goals, planning for careers and major area of interest selection, and problem solving personal/social issues of adolescence and early adulthood.
	Foster collaboration between teachers and guidance staff toward achieving the common goa of connecting the classroom performance with the world of work.
	Input all L-panel guidance interventions (CG0 is a new special code) and meet deadlines.
WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?	
	Your guidance program will not be focused on the needs of your school and key performance indicators may not be positively impacted without full implementation.
	Guidance will be working in isolation and will not be as effective.
	Without L-panel data entry, your school will not have a report that describes the implementation of the guidance program.
	Guidance staff who do not meet deadlines will be noticed to their principals; principals who do not meet deadlines will be noticed to their respective area offices.
W	HO NEEDS TO KNOW?
	Principals and/or assistant principals who oversee the guidance department's activities.
	Guidance directors and school counselors.
H	OW WILL YOU COMMUNICATE FOLLOW-UP?
	The program manager will review key performance indicators with guidance staff and administration and complete the activity assignments in the annual guidance plan.
	Guidance should create a calendar of their plan activities for staff, parents and students.
	Principals will sign the plan electronically indicating their full support of its implementation.
