- Ensure that the instructional materials in the plan have been distributed and are being used for instruction of ELLs.
- Ensure that staff participate in appropriate professional development.

Schools will be compromising the academic achievement of ELLs and, as a result, the attainment of the Adequate Yearly Progress target for the ELL subgroup.
