# K-12 COMPREHENSIVE READING PLAN UPDATES

#### WHAT'S NEW FOR 2007-2008?

- □ A Literacy Leadership Team (LLT), separate from a School Leadership Team, must be established at each school.
- □ All schools, **6**<sup>TH</sup> **thru 12**<sup>TH</sup>, will be placing their progress monitoring data on the Florida Progress Monitoring Reporting Network (PMRN).
- Higher Level 2 (H.S) students may be served in content area classrooms where the teachers have successfully completed the CAR-PD bundle. See attachment for changes to the 11<sup>TH</sup>/12<sup>TH</sup> grade placement criteria.
- Higher Level 2's must have all of the following qualifications: 1) NRT at or above 50%; 2)
  SSS at or above 290; 3) Oral reading fluency at or above 140 cwpm.
- Placement in Intensive Reading coursework consists of specific criteria. Students cannot be placed in coursework solely based on FCAT scores.
- □ Elementary section of K-12 Reading Plan is requiring a **separate** Assessment/Curriculum Decision Tree for all **K-3 students**.
- □ First and second graders will now be progressed monitored using an oral fluency probe. Schools not on the PMRN network must enter this data on Virtual Counselor.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- □ The principal and the Literacy Team will analyze student's data.
- □ The principal will identify the content area teachers who will complete the CAR-PD bundle.
- □ The principal will determine the school's PMRN/VC data-input designee.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

□ Not in compliance with the state initiative K-12 Reading Comprehensive Framework. Monies may be withheld from FEFP.

### WHO NEEDS TO KNOW?

□ Entire district.

### HOW WILL YOU COMMUNICATE FOLLOW-UP?

- □ All stakeholders will be informed with periodical updates.
- □ Principals will disseminate the K-12 Reading Plan guidelines to faculty and staff.
