WHAT'S NEW FOR 2007-2008? ☐ The School District and the Children's Services Council (CSC) formed a partnership for the delivery of services to the schools operating 21st Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) programs. ☐ The partnership with the CSC: (1) combines the CSC's leadership, advocacy and expertise in providing after school services that promote student achievement and family programming with that of the 21st CCLC grant; (2) implements a cost efficient and effective model wherein unwarranted duplication of services is eliminated; (3) places responsibilities for student learning gains and grant documentation on the service delivery provider which will be selected jointly by the school and the CSC; and (4) reduces the District's administrative and instructional delivery costs.
