

## **21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS – NEW SERVICE DELIVERY MODEL**

### **WHAT'S NEW FOR 2007-2008?**

- The School District and the Children's Services Council (CSC) formed a partnership for the delivery of services to the schools operating 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) programs.
- The partnership with the CSC: (1) combines the CSC's leadership, advocacy and expertise in providing after school services that promote student achievement and family programming with that of the 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC grant; (2) implements a cost efficient and effective model wherein unwarranted duplication of services is eliminated; (3) places responsibilities for student learning gains and grant documentation on the service delivery provider which will be selected jointly by the school and the CSC; and (4) reduces the District's administrative and instructional delivery costs.

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?**

- Attend a meeting with key staff members at the District Office and at CSC to discuss the grant and plan strategies to be incorporated into the grant application.

### **WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?**

- The school/district may not be successful in securing the grant.

### **WHO NEEDS TO KNOW?**

- Schools identified by the area superintendents to write for the 2007-08 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant

### **HOW WILL YOU COMMUNICATE FOLLOW-UP?**

- The 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC Program Manager will provide on-going communication with the grant applicants and those schools that are successful in writing the grant.
