WHAT'S NEW FOR 2007-2008? The FLDOE changed the mandatory reporting requirements for the 21st Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) grant program. ☐ The FLDOE has changed how 21st CCLC programs submit their Annual Performance Review (APR) data to the Federal Government. □ The CTACE Department has developed a system to collect the required reporting data through TERMS, which will enable CTACE to report the data on behalf of the 21st CCLC schools. WHAT YOU NEED TO DO? □ 21st CCLC Site Facilitators are required to enter into Terms the names and attendance of the students participating in their 21st CCLC Summer program by August 31, 2007. □ 21st CCLC Site Facilitators are required to enter into TERMS the names and attendance of students participating in the 21st CCLC program on: o November 2, 2007 for attendance period August 20 – October 31, 2007 o January 7, 2008 for attendance period November 1 – December 21, 2007 o March 27, 2008 for attendance period January 7, 2008 – March 26, 2008 June 4, 2008 for attendance period March 27, 2008 – June 5 2008 21st CCLC Site Facilitators are required to return the 21st CCLC Teacher Survey of Individual Participant Academic Progress to the CTACE Department by May 1, 2008. WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T? The state will withhold future 21st CCLC allocations for schools that do not comply and these schools are likely to be audited. WHO NEEDS TO KNOW? ☐ School principals that host 21st CCLC programs.
