SUPERINTENDENT'S SCHOOLS: INTENSIVE, MODERATE OR TARGETED

WHAT'S NEW FOR 2007-2008?

- □ Funding has been allocated to Superintendent Schools that are designated as Intensive, Moderate.
 - At the secondary levels (middle and high) funding is allocated to release department chairs (English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Math, Science) for 1 period per day.
 - Elementary schools will receive funding to release grade chairs for 8 days.
 - Schools designated as targeted (elementary, middle, high) will receive targeted support from the Core Curriculum and HRD Departments.
- □ This model is designed for the purpose of building the internal capacity of each school's core leadership team.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

□ Empower the instructional leaders to meet the requirement of the Board approved job description and Article 9 of the BTU contract which outline duties such as staff training, modeling best practices, coaching department peers and also mentoring.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

□ The funding will be rescinded.

WHO NEEDS TO KNOW?

 \Box All faculty and staff.

HOW WILL YOU COMMUNICATE FOLLOW-UP?

Follow up will be communicated during c-Net and Instructional Council meetings. In addition continuous feedback will be shared with Department Chairs, Assistant Principals' and the Principal.
