WHAT'S NEW FOR 2010-2011?

- Behavioral & Academic Support Information System (B.A.S.I.S)
 - Electronic tool for teachers, guidance counselors, social workers, family counselors, and community partners to document social, emotional and academic issues for students and the interventions relating to such.
 - Early warning system identifying at-risk students based on certain indicators.
- Pilot- August, 2010-December, 2010
- Expected roll out to all schools January, 2011
