

School Environmental Safety Reporting Changes

WHAT'S NEW FOR 2010-2011?

- New Department of Education discipline reporting requirements
 - Bullying and Harassment incidents will be reported under separate categories
 - New indicators related to Bullying and or Harassment
 - Unsubstantiated Bullying **must be** reported
 - New reporting requirements relating to weapons
 - New reporting requirements relating to drug possession and drug description
 - New reporting requirements related to injuries resulting from a disciplinary incident
 - New reporting requirements relating to reporting events to law enforcement
 - New reporting requirements for alcohol, gang and hate crime related events

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- Continue to follow the guidelines from the Discipline Matrix when identifying and coding disciplinary events.
- Document **all** discipline events through the Discipline Management System.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- Improper documentation of disciplinary events will result in FTE survey errors.

WHO NEEDS TO KNOW?

- Behavior Specialists
- School-Based Administrators that handle disciplinary events
