## WHAT'S NEW FOR 2009-2010?

- 🍏 A five-part, full-day training module will be offered for new media specialists (novice and experienced) in Broward County schools. The dates will be August 26, 2009, Session 1; September 22, 2009, Session 2; October 22, 2009, Session 3; November 17, Sessions 4/5; and on December 9, 2009, new media specialists will be invited to a LINKS (Library Integration Network Support) Cadre Showcase, featuring exemplary school library media programs.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- 🍏 If you have a new media specialist, release him or her to attend the training sessions and the LINKS Cadre Showcase.

## WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- 🍏 An uninformed media specialist cannot efficiently integrate new instructional technologies and district resources with your school's learning objectives, which may negatively impact student achievement and teacher productivity.
- 🍏 A school may be out of compliance with the CCC settlement agreement through poor management, allocation, and use of resources.
- 🍏 A 21<sup>st</sup> century school library media program integrating Information Literacy skills may not be implemented.
