WHAT'S NEW FOR 2009-2010?

- Beginning on July 1, 2009, the option or choice of receiving ESOL services at an ESOL Cluster School will no longer be available.
- The home school must provide ESOL services to all students who register and qualify for the ESOL Program.
- ★ The Cluster School option has been removed from the ESOL form titled Parent Notification of Student Placement in the English for Speakers of Other Languages Program.
- ★ The decision to eliminate ESOL Cluster Schools was approved and supported by the Principal Executive Groups as well as Instructional Council.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- ♠ Notify all pertinent staff members of this important change in ESOL student placement.
- ♠ Ensure that school staff is using the updated form titled Parent Notification of Student Placement in the English for Speakers of Other Languages Program when notifying parents of entry into the ESOL program.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

Students will not be serviced by the home school, which will impact funding.
