

## **ELEMENTARY: MATHEMATICS**

### **WHAT'S NEW FOR 2010-2011?**

- New K–5 Math program, Go Math! includes a Math Board for every student, Grab-n-Go! math center for every classroom, digital resources such as iTools, Destination Math, Mega Math, Soar to Success, Online Intervention Tool, Future Channels, and staff development podcasts for teachers.
- New Mathematics Textbook Adoption Trainers available for curriculum support and staff development needs at schools. Contact the Mathematics Department to schedule support.
- Go Math! program includes mini-assessments, Chapter Tests, and Big Idea Assessments that replace QBATs for all grade levels K-5.
- New K-5 Instructional Focus Calendars aligned to the NGSSS and Go Math! linked to BEEP lessons.
- New K-5 Math BEEP lessons with links to digital resources for each lesson.
- New K-5 student-friendly benchmarks and new K-5 Integrated Curriculum Maps.
- New grades 4 and 5 Project/Enrichment Program (PEP) resources for Level 5 math students (formerly MaTS).

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?**

- During pre-planning week schedule a 3-hour Go Math! training facilitated by teachers who attended the summer workshops to disseminate information to their grade level teams.
- Visit the Elementary Math CAB conference often for Go Math! and other resources.
