WHAT'S NEW FOR 2010-2011?

The Perkins Grant Funding formula will change in 2010-11 which will impact future Perkins funding at each eligible high school. The new funding formula will positively impact schools financially based upon the number of CTE Concentrators and student attainment of an industry credential.

♠ Ensure that the school is in compliance with the 2010-11 Carl Perkins Guidelines, e-mailed to the principals of all eligible high schools with the notification of their 2010-11 Perkins funding

• Perkins funding in 2011-12 and beyond may be jeopardized or the amount of grant funding the school will receive may be negatively impacted.
