

## **HIGH SCHOOL: ENGLISH IV - FLORIDA COLLEGE PREP COURSE**

### **WHAT'S NEW FOR 2010-2011?**

- 🍏 The State of Florida has created a new course for FCAT Reading Levels II and III students who did not score a college-readiness score on the CPT. It is a full-year course that satisfies the English IV course requirement for graduation and is to be available during the 2010 – 2011 school year.

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?**

- 🍏 Determine whether your school has enough students who failed the CPT and who are interested in taking this course for their English IV requirement. If so, schedule the course and appoint a teacher.

### **WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?**

- 🍏 Students will not have the opportunity to take this course that was designed to remediate specific students and help them become college-ready.

### **WHO NEEDS TO KNOW?**

- 🍏 Students who did not pass the CPT, their parents, guidance personnel, and English teachers.

### **HOW WILL YOU COMMUNICATE FOLLOW-UP?**

- 🍏 After the Department of Education offers training on the course on July 12 in Palm Beach County and after the course is placed into the Florida Course Code Directory, Broward will notify schools as to the appropriate procedure.
