

MIDDLE SCHOOL: INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS PROTOCOL

WHAT'S NEW FOR 2010-2011?

- 🍏 The District will be purchasing the newly State adopted and District core Middle School Mathematics; General Math Grades 6 through 8, Advanced Math Grades 6 through 8, GEM Math Grade 6, GEM Math Grades 7 and 8, and GEM Math Grade 8.
- 🍏 Schools will receive Maintenance of Effort (MOE) funds as part of the textbook replacement plan. The tentative rate per FTE, which will be adjusted, based on the twentieth day FTE, is \$12.00 for middle schools.
- 🍏 The schools will receive in August funds collected at each site for lost and damaged textbooks during the 2009-2010 school year as part of the textbook replacement plan.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO?

- 🍏 Take an inventory of all core textbooks to determine the total on hand count by core subject.
- 🍏 Identify gaps and/or surpluses for each subject.
- 🍏 Determine your core needs based on course or student enrollment.
- 🍏 Work with neighboring schools to balance your textbook needs.
- 🍏 Contact the District Textbook Facilitator through the Learning Resources and Instructional Materials Dept for information on purchasing additional materials.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF YOU DON'T?

- 🍏 Schools will not have the adequate materials needed.
