2017-2018 Parent and Family Engagement Survey Summary Results (H-1)

Number of Parents Surveyed

131

Section 1 – Did you receive information from your child’s school about awareness of standards and testing?

87.6% of the parents surveyed feel that they received information from your child’s school about awareness of standards and testing. (percentage is combined agree and strongly agree)
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Section 2 – Did you receive materials from your child’s school about helping your child with school?

84.6% of the parents surveyed feel that they receive information on how to collaborate with the teacher to help their child succeed. (percentage is combined agree and strongly agree)
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Section 3 – Did you and your child’s school collaborate?

71.8% of the parents surveyed feel that they receive materials to help work with their child to do better in school. (percentage is combined agree and strongly agree)
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Section 4 – Did you and your child’s school have an open line of communication?

92.2% of the parents feel that they know how to contact their child’s teachers and the information received is easily understood. (percentage is combined agree and strongly agree)

Section 5 – Was your child’s school open to parental Involvement?

51.3% of the parents surveyed asked for specific information or materials and about 75% of those parents were satisfied with the response.
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Where did you get information about standards, testing, and helping your child succeed in school?

86.7% of parents received information from a conference with their child’s teacher. 51.4% received information from a friend, relative or other parent. 46.2% received information from the district website.

The data generated from the deficient areas will be reviewed and analyzed with the School Advisory Council (SAC), and used to plan the parent and family engagement activities for the 2018-2019 school year.
