## School

Cooper City High School (CCHS) is located in Cooper City, FL and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. CCHS is a comprehensive public school, nationally acclaimed as a Blue Ribbon School and one of America's Best High Schools by *The Washington Post* and *Newsweek* – 137<sup>th</sup> in Florida and 999 in the nation. Moreover, the school has been recognized by Broward County Public Schools for its 95% graduation rate – one of the highest in the county – and by the state of Florida for the 5-Star School Award. CCHS has 2291 students, grades 9 through 12, with a culturally diverse population: 53% White, 27% Hispanic/Latino, 7% Black, 6% Asian and 2% Multi-racial or Other. Cooper City High School offers 18 Advanced Placement classes as well as 45 honors classes. ## Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment

In 2015, 700 CCHS students took over 1200 AP tests in 25 subjects, and 63% scored 3 or higher. In 2015, 150 students took Dual Enrollment courses and 28 students were Early Admission students at Broward College, Florida Atlantic University and University of Florida.

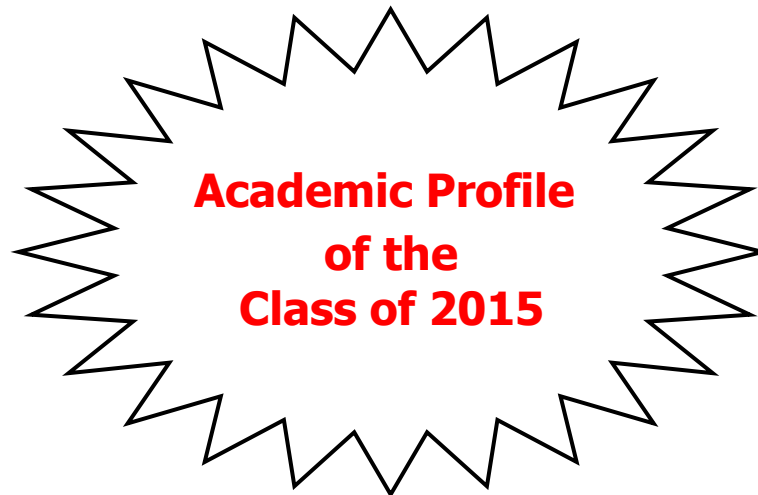
