As part of the admissions process for Broward College and before enrolling in the College Academy, you must take the College's Basic Skills Assessment Test called the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT). The PERT has three sections that you must pass: Reading, Writing, and Math. The testing takes approximately 2.5 hours and is done on a computer. The PERT is not an easy test, particularly in the math area. Remember CA will review PERT testing history. Applicants may only test once.

- $\quad$ Students who meet initial criteria will have their status on the online application changed to proceed to the test and have the ability to print the Pert testing ticket.
- Print the testing ticket and go to a testing center near you.
