“Were changes made to one or more postsecondary goals?”

(check one and do nothing else—we will discuss parent approves the changes at the meeting) As we discussed, the first time the student becomes a Transition IEP we will check “No” as they have never had postsecondary goals. If the student has a different goal from the previous year, then you must check “YES”.

SVE ESE Students--_____ is being prepared to graduate with a standard diploma for students with disabilities by participating in a self-contained class with instruction on the Florida Access Points. (The following will be added at the IEP meeting: Students and parents have been informed of the standard diploma for students with disabilities option and designations via this IEP meeting and finalized IEP document.)

SVE students only—check “Yes” and we will complete the section under at the meeting. Yes must be checked because the student is no longer on a special diploma option.

General education ESE students—check “No” as their option has not been changed.

“Is the student deferring receipt of a standard high school diploma pursuant to s. 1003.4282(11)(c), F.S.?”

Everyone with check “Not yet determined”. This will be determined once the student enters high school.
