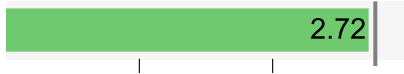

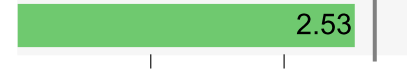

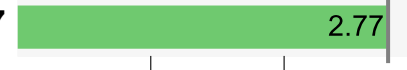

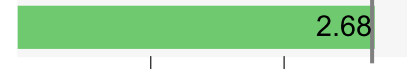

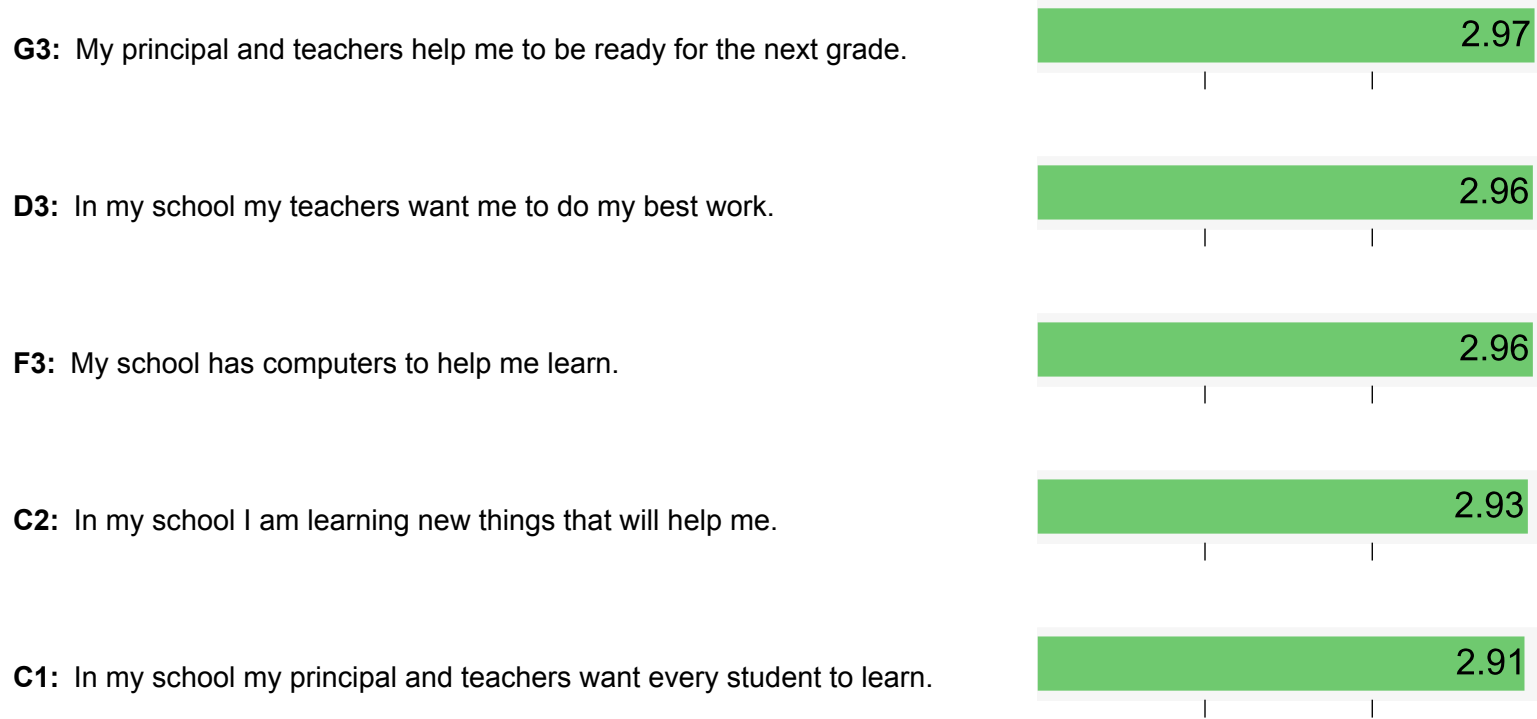

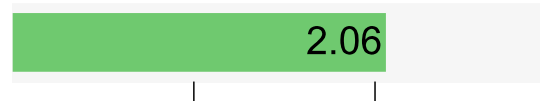

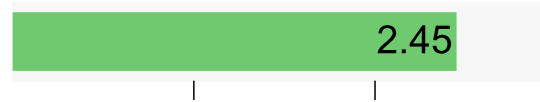

G1: My principal and teachers ask me what I think about school.



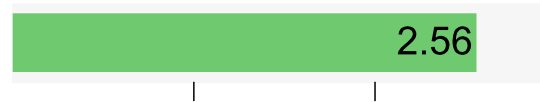
F1: My school is safe and clean.
