# Innovative Programs

**Quantum Leap** is an academically advanced program designed to challenge motivated students to maximize their academic capabilities.

**AP Capstone Program** is a two-year sequence program in which students examine topics in depth to develop their writing, evidence-building and public-speaking skills to earn the AP Capstone diploma.

**Study Abroad:** Through Broward College our students participated in the Study Abroad Program.
