Happy Tuesday!

We hope your week is off to a great start. In today's update you'll find the latest i-Ready instructional usage for your school, answers to some of the most common concerns about usage, and a quick spotlight on a member of our team.

## **True or False?**

We often hear from educators with questions about time on task and pass rates in i-Ready. We've addressed a few of the most common misconceptions and concerns below.

- 1. All lessons count toward student's time on task – i-Ready-assigned *and* teacher-assigned.**  
**TRUE.** Rest assured, whether students are working in their personalized paths, or in a teacher-assigned lesson targeting specific skills, time spent actively working in any lesson counts toward instruction time for the week.
- 2. Time spent on Standards Mastery Checks is included in online instruction time.**  
**FALSE.** Only i-Ready *lessons* count in instruction time. Diagnostic, Standards Mastery and Growth Monitoring assessments are never included in instructional usage.
- 3. Lesson Pass Rates are an average of students' scores on their lesson quizzes.**  
**FALSE.** Passing rates, also called *% of Lessons Passed* in the new class and student reports, are based on number of lessons passed divided by the number of completed lessons. When student pass rates dip below 70%, this is a strong indicator that students are struggling and require teacher intervention.

 ⚠️ **Yellow Alert:** Struggling with lesson alert. Student is at risk of having a domain shut off.

**Time on Task:**  
 Goal: 30-49 minutes per subject each week.  
 Between 30 and 49 minutes of usage is considered a healthy range of online instructional time.
