- What patterns do we see in student practices?
 - Students can point out labels and headings, but are still learning the academic language.
 - o Students test taking stamina is improving.
- What are the common errors among students?
 - o Students skip text features when reading.
 - o Compare/contrast two passages (discussed reversing the test)
- What have students mastered?
 - Still in progress

i-Ready Data

- What does the data show regarding student engagement and effort?
 - o Students are not completing 45 minutes of math and reading.
 - o Many students are not doing i-Ready minutes at home. Parents have been told in conferences, but they are still not doing it.
 - o The lower percentile students are having difficulty staying focused.
- What adjustments have been made for individual students?
 - Monitor their time on task.
 - O Sitting next to them and helping them log in to i-Ready.
 - o Changing i-Ready passwords to make sign on easier.
 - o Conferencing with students that are scoring less than 70% on lessons.
 - o Using i-Ready Reward Chart for lessons passed to motivate students.
 - o Adding lesson focused on a target skill.

 - Lack of conventions, spelling, creating sentences, writing stamina, providing enough details
 - o Improving on topic focus
- What are the common errors among students?
 - o Lack of conventions, spelling, creating sentences, writing, stamina

- What have students mastered?
 - Still in progress

Discussion and analysis of student work samples

- What patterns do we see in student practices?
 - Students lack test taking stamina
 - o Students have not had enough practice writing to explain their answers
- What are the common errors among students?
 - o Not following along; staying on track.
 - Misinterpreting the meaning of the story problem; having difficulty with the unknown number
 - Writing to explain their answers
 - o Reversing operations
- What have students mastered?
 - Still in progress

i-Ready Data

- What does the data show regarding student engagement and effort?
 - o More lessons are being passed on i-Ready Math than Reading

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- What adjustments have been made for individual students?
 - Sitting next to them and helping them log in to i-Ready.
 - o Changing i-Ready passwords to make sign on easier.
 - o Conferencing with students that are scoring less than 70% on lessons.
 - o Using i-Ready Reward Chart for lessons passed to motivate students.
 - o Providing students with paper/pencil or whiteboard to solve problems.
 - o Adding lessons specific to the standard and skill being taught.
