








- a. Catering was provided by Chef Richard with Culinary Flair; 561-254-6557

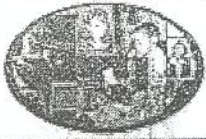
